A Celebration of Black Entrepreneurs

WATERLOO, ONTARIO (March 7, 2023) - The LiftOff BY CCAWR Black Entrepreneurship Program is thrilled to announce its upcoming spring LiftOff Launchers event on Friday, March 24 at 5 PM EST. The theme of this event is Building Community, which is designed to showcase the achievements of Black entrepreneurs and their contributions to the Black business ecosystem. The event will also feature entrepreneurs who are either currently enrolled in or have completed the LiftOff Program.
